3 s<sup>d</sup> Rġd to remove & Convey.  
4 & to the Churchwardens & Overseers of th<sup>e</sup> Poor of th<sup>e</sup>  
5 Township of Carperby Cum Theasby in th<sup>e</sup> North  
6 Rġd of th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> County to receive & provide for &  
7 to each & every of them & These  
8 Whereas Compl<sup>t</sup> has been made unto us whose Names  
9 are Subscribed, two of his Magesties justices of th<sup>e</sup>  
10 Peace, (& Quor) for th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Rġd, by th<sup>e</sup> Churchwardens &  
11 Overseers of th<sup>e</sup> Poor of Cunniston Cum Kilnsay afores<sup>d</sup>  
12 that Mary Lawson Widdow was upon th<sup>e</sup> eight day of  
13 October last Past, by the Practice, fraud, & other  
14 unwarrantable means of the Inhabitants of Car-  
15 -perby Cum Theasby afores<sup>d</sup> or some of them  
16 brought into th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Township of Cunniston Cum Kilnsay  
17 where she was within th<sup>e</sup> Space of twenty four hours  
18 next afterwards, deliver'd of a female Bastard  
19 child since Christned by the Name of Sarah, endeavour-  
20 -ing to Settle her Selfe & her s<sup>d</sup> Bastard Child there w<sup>ch</sup>  
21 s<sup>d</sup> Mary Lawson is a poor p<sup>son</sup>, & the & her s<sup>d</sup> Bastard  
22 child likely to become chargeable to th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Township of  
23 Cunniston Cum Kilnsay afores<sup>d</sup>, w<sup>thin</sup> w<sup>ch</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Township of  
24 Cunniston Cum Kilnsay they have gain'd No legal Settle-  
25 -ment, but are poor & likely to become chargeable to th<sup>e</sup>  
26 Inhabitants therof upon examination whereof, we th<sup>e</sup>

27 s<sup>d</sup> justices doe hereby find & adjudge th<sup>e</sup> Same to be true  
28 & that the place of their last legall Settlement is att  
29 Carperby Cum Theasby afores<sup>d</sup>.  
30 These are (therefore in his Ma<sup>e</sup>tys Name) to charge & comānd you th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup>  
31 Churchwardens & Overseers of th<sup>e</sup> Poor of Cunniston Cum Kilnsay afores<sup>d</sup> you,  
32 some or one of you, Immediatly upon Sight hereof, to remove & Convey th<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup>  
33 Mary Lawson & her s<sup>d</sup> Bastard Child, out of th<sup>e</sup> < s<sup>d</sup> > Township of Cunniston Cum  
34 Kilnsay afores<sup>d</sup>, to th<sup>e</sup> Township of Carperby Cum Theasby afores<sup>d</sup> & then  
35 deliver to th<sup>e</sup> Churchwardens & Overseers of th<sup>e</sup> poor thereof, together w<sup>th</sup> this  
36 our order, or a true Cobby thereof, who are hereby required to receive  
37 & provide for them, as for the Poor of their s<sup>d</sup> Township of Carperby Cum Theasby  
38 herein fail Not att [?ost] [?pills] given under our hands & seals this 12<sup>th</sup> day of  
39 November Annoq Dom: 1728.
