Archaeological Services WYAS undertook excavations at Hawbank Field, Skipton in advance of a residential development in the winter of 2021. They discovered evidence of a Romano-British settlement which was occupied between the 2nd and 5th centuries AD, including traces of buildings, cobbled floors, ditches and earth banks. Two burials were also associated with the settlement.
