HOLIDAY MAKING AT EMBSAY.

The steam whistle at Haw Bank Quarries, Embsay, announced the fact that the armistice had been signed.

Some minutes later at the Embsay Manufacturing Co.'s shed was also conveying the glad tidings to the neighbourhood.

The flag was soon hoisted on the tower of the Embsay Parish Church and within a very short time the village was decorated with flags and bunting in all directions.

The local works were closed down for the remainder of the day.
