**Information for the walk:** Meet for 10.30 at the Carleton village shop. Parking available in the village.

**Terrain:** A steep walk of about 1.5 miles from The Wend and up fields with two steep paths to cross tributary streams on the way to Lane Head Farm, a 17th century house and barn, now three houses. This walk will involve crossing two becks and field stiles.

An easier walk back through part of the Broughton Hall estate, a more gentle route through fields to old village housing and Beckside.

**Equipment:** Stout footwear recommended.

Bring some lunch, refreshments and toilet at Sue's, Lane Head Croft which we will visit.
