#### Property history =

1573 (10 Feb) – Peter Yorke gave original lease (3,000 yrs) to Edward Whalley of Blagburne, then occupied by Wm. Batty.

The property – a messuage in Kilnsey plus 80 acres - came with a share of common rights:-

- K. Common [which was divided into 25 parts] the lease gave  $1 + \frac{1}{3}$  parts
- K. Woods [which was divided into 35 parts] the lease came with  $1 + \frac{1}{3}$  parts
- mineral rights

BUT: excluded hunting & fishing rights.

Edward Whalley retained easement rights to transport timber from K. Woods. He paid:-

- 2s 8d p.a. (to Peter Yorke) towards the tithes due to the Crown
- plus 1½d annual rent each Michaelmas to the Yorkes
- and paid suit to the Court Baron and the Mill.

**1592** – Edward Whalley granted the lease on the same conditions to Thomas Whalley of Blagburne.

**1614** (August 10) - John Batty paid £250 to Thomas Whalley for the lease, on the same conditions

### This Indenture:-

1614 (11 Sept) - Christopher Wade paid John Batty £343 for:-

- Batty's 3-parts share of Beggarflatts Close
- The whole of Heslehead close
- 2 sellions & "one little parcel" of ground in Sandholme
- The Great Acre (alias Broadpiece) under Kilnsev Scar
- One-half acre under the Scar "a little above the said Great Acre"
- Sidgate Land (half-acre)
- 4 cattlegates on the Sleights & 4 on Ox Pasture.
- 1 + ⅓ parts of K. Common
- Share of Kilnsey Woods 1 + 1/3<sup>rd</sup> part

Wade to pay 8d p.a. each Michaelmas in tithe to the Crown, suit to the Court & Mill.

#### QUERY:-

It seems John Batty only sold part of his recently acquired property from the "Yorke lease" on to C. Wade – not the whole estate. How / why did he sell, within a month of purchase, at a price well above what he had paid for the whole lease? Is it significant that he sold on all the common grazing rights to Wade – but not his share of the woods? It's not explicitly clear who pays the 8s 8d rent on the property or to whom in 1614. Why is 7 years given for the conveyance to be completed?
