Distance: c. 10km **Terrain:** Mostly on Public Right of Ways. Initial ascent of 90m over a distance of 1.3km, thereafter minimal ascent.

Personal equipment: As always, be ready for the variety of local weather! Stout walking boots and waterproofs essential, also sun protection. **Refreshments:** Please bring your own drinks and lunch.
