



The Sleights Pasture prehistoric monument complex, between Ingleborough and Ribbleshead, though one of the largest ritual sites in the Yorkshire Dales, has been under-researched and little regarded until recently. Surveys and fieldwork by the Ingleborough Archaeology Group led by Yvonne Luke have transformed our understanding of the site, the nature of the principal monuments, their development and use.
