Langstrothdale.

Langstrothdale - the 'long valley valley' - was a medieval hunting chase and still displays elements of its long history, in terms of very olde walles, ruinous structures and relict landscapes. This walk starts at Yockenthwaite and follows a high-level route to Cray then descends to Hubberholme and back along the riverside to Yockenthwaite.

Information for the walk: Parking is off-road a short distance beyond Yockenthwaite. (SD9023279166) Meet at the bridge over the river (SD9043979033).

Terrain: Public rights of way throughout. Some narrow, uneven paths.

Equipment: Boots or strong walking shoes are advised. and clothing full waterproofs and sunscreen - usual summer Dales equipment!

Bring a packed lunch and drinks. Sorry no dogs.

Toilets: The pub in Hubberholme (which I think are external).
