This walk of approximately 2.5 miles will take in the earthwork remains of late prehistoric and Roman period settlements, medieval fields, the probable remains of Fountains Abbey's sheephouse and historic fields and barns.

Pat was involved in the recording and investigation of many of these features, both through the School of Continuing Education at the University of Leeds and most recently with colleagues in the UWHG - this walk is dedicated to her memory.

**Car parking and meeting point:** Meet: Conistone Bridge (roadside parking). Start: 1.30pm  
Return: by 4.30pm.

**Distance:** c. 2.5 miles / 4km

**Terrain:** The route is mostly along footpaths and tracks but we will also be crossing pasture and rough grazing: stout footwear and full waterproofs essential (and possibly sunscreen). As always, be ready for the variety of local weather!

**Note:** While all restrictions relating to Covid-19 have now been lifted we would ask those attending to display appropriate caution in order to mitigate the risk of infection spread.
