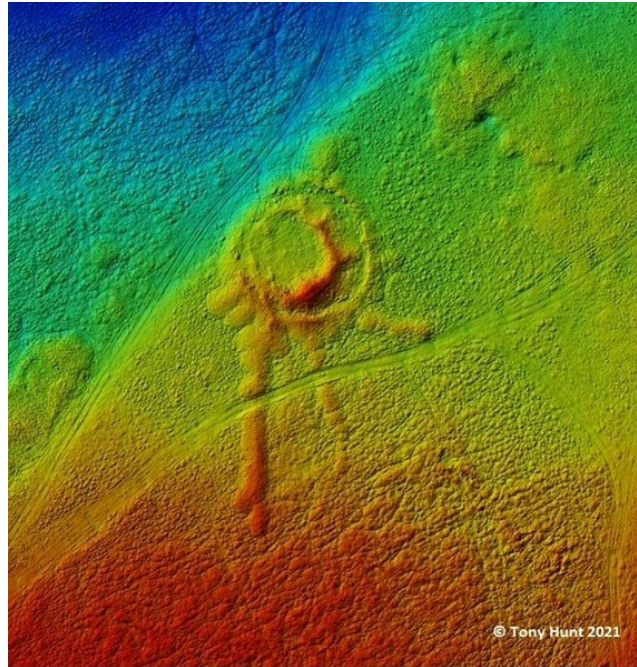

Sleights Pasture Prehistoric Monument Complex

Walk led by Yvonne Luke



Yvonne Luke will lead a walk to the Sleights Pasture prehistoric monument complex between Ingleborough and Ribbleshead to follow on from her talk in April. One of the largest ritual sites in the Yorkshire Dales, it has been under-researched and little regarded until recently. Surveys and fieldwork by the Ingleborough Archaeology Group led by Yvonne have transformed our understanding of the site, the nature of the principal monuments, their development and use.

Information for the walk: Parking and meeting point - parking is very limited near Sleights Pasture so we shall meet at Ribbleshead, where there is ample parking along the B6255, then car share.

Terrain: Mainly on level ground but people should be careful of the ground in the area of the cairn which is more uneven. There may be cattle in the pasture but it is an enormous area and we shall take action to avoid them.

Equipment: The ground is usually dry but boots are advisable, not trainers, and clothing full waterproofs and sunscreen - usual summer Dales equipment!

Bring a packed lunch and drinks. Sorry no dogs.
