Take a gentle walk from Embsay reservoir down Pasture Road to the centre of the village

Walk led by Embsay-with-Eastby Historical Research Group



This one road is rich in local history - the tour will offer insights into the historic landscape, industrial past, and social history of Embsay.

Information for the walk: Meet at the reservoir car park grid reference SD 99945441. Buses are available on an hourly basis from Skipton to the village centre, from where there is a 20-25 minute walk up the hill to the reservoir. For those who need it, lifts will be available back up the hill to the reservoir car park after the walk.

There are no public toilets, but there are two pubs and a coffee shop in the village which you may wish to patronise after the tour.

Terrain: The walk, much of it downhill, will be on metalled road and pavements throughout.

Equipment: Stout shoes are recommended and clothing for the day's weather. Dogs on leads welcome.
